

ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

The Conference for Church Musicians is held at the beautiful Green Lake Conference Center in Wisconsin. Conferees of all ages are able to work with nationally and internationally renowned clinicians in both ensemble and workshop settings. Workshops are designed to further educate and train those involved in church music leadership. In addition to daytime activities, the conference has 6 evening concerts.

Adult Choir: The adult choir is composed of about 200 voices and sings choral literature in a variety of styles.

Young Adult Choir: In addition to participation in adult choir and workshops, Young Adult Choir members, 18-25 years, have their own choir, Bible study, and social events.

Instruments: There are ample opportunities for instrumentalists. Organ workshops are scheduled throughout the week. Three levels of handbell choirs and a full orchestra prepare daily for concerts shared at the end of the week. Other workshops and ensembles play throughout the week.

Youth: Students entering 8th grade through those completing 12th grade may join the youth choir. Students may reside in Robbins Hall or may room with parents or guardians. The youth choir has special social events and activities scheduled throughout the week.

Children: Students entering 3rd through 7th grade participate in the children's choir. Older children also have the opportunity to join a middle school choir (6th-7th grades) and a handbell choir.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

Signing up for the conference is a two step process.

1. Complete and mail the conference registration form (either attached form or downloaded from the FABM website (www.fabm.com) and include appropriate fees. OR, *new this year*, single and family registrations may be completed online!
2. Call the Green Lake Conference Center, 1.800.558.8898, to make housing reservations. Many housing options are available, including lodge, cabin, and camping. Housing is reserved for FABM conferees until 5/10/10. Ask about scholarships. Special GLCC housing scholarships are also available for members of the young adult choir.

LATE FEES AND CANCELLATION POLICY

Conference fees postmarked after **June 15, 2010**, will require an additional \$25.00 late registration fee.

Registration fees are non-refundable after June 15, 2010.
